Bistro 107 is a quaint restaurant open for lunch and dinner. The atmosphere is wonderful and has a beautiful piano, and I noticed a very nice bar area for night-time entertaining, I believe. The service here is marvelous. I am told from our server that the chef is the owner, with many years of experience, and this is evident. I tasted the soup of the day, which was shrimp bisque, and was surprised that the broth was thin, fresh and very tasty with shrimp, sausage and corn. The bread and butter seemed homemade with fresh herbs, and were very good. I ordered a vegetable club for lunch, which consisted of portobello mushroom, roasted pepper and a spread served on slightly toasted bread. This was served with fresh cut french fries.
